Tips & Tricks for Implementation

- Consider sending two parent educators or supervisor with parent educator if families have multiple children or there are safety concerns (we can reimburse that!).
- 2. Partner with local districts to learn about community resources if you have an out-of-district referral.
- 3. Planning weekly visits can be intense focus on families' needs and goals to guide planning.
