A Bright Future's Mom reported how thankful she is that her PE connected her with ITS for her son to receive speech therapy. Mom wasn't aware how far behind he was, nor that there were services that would come to her house to help her child. Mom is also very thankful for the iPAD she has received. It has helped with ITS speech when they had to do zoom visits, as well as using it for Bright Futures zoom visits. Mom reported her phone doesn't always work well, so the equipment has been instrumental in Mom being able to connect with services. She also uses the iPAD for her visits with JCMH and her NA/AA meetings.
