



REGIONAL SPOTLIGHT-HUTCHINSON

My BF family has completed their required weekly visits this month successfully & will be moving to bi-weekly effective July 1st. I was able to sit down with them and help them fill out all the paperwork for state assistance. They are now receiving benefits for food, childcare, medical and utilities through the state. They have also submitted all their paperwork for Section 8 housing & should hear something back within the next month. We also worked on completing a resume, applying for jobs, and reviewed what a typical job interview looks like. Within the last month and half, these parents have both been able to obtain stable employment. Their daughter is up to date on her well child visits and immunizations. Due to her parents being completely invested in her development, she is currently working on milestones above her age group.
