# ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BECOMING A PARENT EDUCATOR FOR KPATA BRIGHT FUTURES?

### THE GOAL:

We will work to provide home visits to at-risk families in areas of Kansas that consistently receive a large number of Bright Futures referrals from DCF and where there is no capacity with the local program. Families will receive visits once a week for the first 3 months and then a minimum of twice a month for the remainder of a year. This position will be part-time (max. of 10hrs/week) and can be completed in addition to a current role as a certified parent educator.

Previous certification as a parent educator from the Parents as Teachers National Office is desirable. The focus area for hiring (due to referral intake) is in the Central part of KS and educators who reside within an hour of these locations.


