ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BECOMING A PARENT EDUCATOR FOR KPATA BRIGHT FUTURES?

THE GOAL:

We will work to provide home visits to at-risk families in areas of Kansas that consistently receive a large number of Bright Futures referrals from DCF and where there is no capacity with the local program. Families will receive visits once a week for the first 3 months and then a minimum of twice a month for the remainder of a year. This position will be part-time (max. of 10hrs/week) and can be completed in addition to a current role as a certified parent educator.

Previous certification as a parent educator from the Parents as Teachers National Office is desirable. **We welcome all candidates to apply and are expanding the search for educators that can provide services to all areas of Kansas.**
