

When I asked mom what has been most helpful about our time together so far, she stated that she has appreciated me talking about the importance of holding her baby and responding consistently to her baby's cues and how this relates to attachment and brain development. She has been getting messages from those around her that she is spoiling her baby and she has appreciated my encouragement. I have talked to her a lot about tummy time and she has been reluctant to do this saying that her baby doesn't like it. After our virtual visit at the beginning of the month, she sent me photos of him doing tummy time!

MOUTHS IN MOTION IS AN INTERACTIVE CLASS THAT OFFERS PRACTICAL TIPS, GUIDELINES, AND ACTIVITIES TO HELP CHILDREN WHO NEED TO GET THEIR "MOUTHS IN MOTION." MANY CHILDREN WHO HAVE DELAYED SPEECH AND LANGUAGE SKILLS, ALSO HAVE POOR MUSCLE CONTROL, LACK OF COORDINATION, OR SENSITIVITY ISSUES. BECAUSE THE SAME MUSCLES WE USE FOR CHEWING, SUCKING AND SWALLOWING ARE ALSO THE MUSCLES WE USE FOR SPEECH, WE OFTEN NEED TO ADDRESS ORAL MOTOR ISSUES IN CONJUNCTION WITH HELPING TO IMPROVE SPEECH AND LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT. THIS CLASS OFFERS EASY, LOW COST SUGGESTIONS THAT KIDS WILL LOVE WHILE HELPING TO IMPROVE THEIR ORAL MOTOR SKILLS.

Cost: training is free for KPATA members or \$30 for non-members. KPATA membership covers the cost of Bright futures Program trainings for the program year.
