HHS Launches New Maternal Mental Health Hotline

Hotline is the latest move of the Biden-Harris Administration to strengthen both maternal health and mental health; President's FY23 Budget would double the initial investment in the hotline.


Today, the U.S. Health and Human Services Department's Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) announced the launch of the Maternal Mental Health Hotline, a new, confidential, toll-free hotline for expecting and new moms experiencing mental health challenges. With an initial \$3 million investment, the hotline will launch on Mother's Day, May 8, 2022, with counselors available to provide mental health support. The President's Fiscal Year 2023 Budget would more than double this initial investment, allowing HRSA to expand the Maternal Mental Health Hotline's expert staffing and build additional capacity in its future phases.

This family started out with a few no shows and not very good or consistent communication. She was kind of quiet and reserved during our visits in the beginning. Several months later she was keeping all of her visits, letting me know if she needed to cancel because of illness and actively rescheduling. She even agreed to zoom calls a few times due to covid quarantines and was more than willing to gather materials for activities and have it set up and ready to go for our zoom call. She has been open and communicative during visits and asks questions and asks for suggestions to anything she is struggling with. It has been so encouraging to see her implement some of those suggestions (a few times during that same visit!) or have her tell me about what she has tried between visits and what has helped. We talked about the importance of one on one time with the kids and as a working Mom with 3 kids how hard that can be! The next visit she told me that she had staggered their bedtimes so she can get that much needed time in with each of them and how much she and the kids were enjoying it! Through my referral, she followed up and is now receiving speech services for one of her kids and has also gotten another one enrolled for Head Start preschool in the fall. She is open and willing to try new things and I can truly see that she just wants to do her best!
