



In the last month, PE and Mom have been working on colors, toilet training, and discipline. Mom has noticed a huge improvement in child's development and continues to improve. Mom does an amazing job following thru with all the activities during the visit and after the visit. Mom normally sends PE a photo or video of how child has been enjoying the activity. Mom had set a goal to help child get comfortable with the potty chair. Mom told PE she feels like she has accomplished the goal and is ready to take the next step. Now, starting next week, they will focus on setting a timer to help her remember to use the potty chair. Mom also has done an amazing job using positive discipline- she has been using a safe spot to help child if she is having a bad moment. This has also worked so well for the whole family. Mom feels pretty good accomplishing all the goals and activities this past month.


