This month the family achieved their goal of moving into a house. The boys are both achieving many of their milestones by grasping objects, beginning to roll over, smiling at family members, and reaching out for one another. Mom reported that they are sleeping well and almost through the night. Dad started a new job and feels that it may be more secure than the one he had previously. Mom reported that Birth to 3 was impressed with some of the activities the family has been doing through the BF program- making the accordion book and the mobile. Mom sent PE a video of one of the children batting at the hanging toys, which was a new milestone that she was working with him to accomplish. Mom would like to get her HS diploma and PE shared with her about the Wichita Public Schools Chester E Lewis program- she has enrolled for this August! Mom is currently talking with her boss about working from home so that she can still be with the boys but is also looking at childcare options in case that doesn't work out.
