Mom said she would think about setting a goal and how that may work in her life. Mom's older daughters are visiting more now that she has housing which both mom and child obviously enjoy.



- Advocacy and relationship building in Topeka that over the years has kept KS PAT programs front and center with secured funding.
- The 2022 Conference Lighting the Spark Again, April 11 & 12, 2022, that brought together approximately half the state's parent educators for training and connections.
- Payment of the annual PATNC affiliate fee for KS PAT programs who have signed assurances with Bright Futures.
- In the last 12 months (Nov '21 to Oct '22): \$417,475.16 to local PAT programs who serve Bright Futures families.
