Attended Charlie's House tour to learn about safety in the household and preventing accidents. [Mom] held [child] and waited for her to warm up to the person giving the Charlie's House tour. [Mom] encouraged [child] to stay close when she put her down and interacted with her throughout the visit. When [child] walked over to the bathtub. [mom] moved closer to prevent her from falling. [Mom] asked questions throughout the tour about child safety and how to use child safety products in her home. Charlie's House had free child proofing equipment at the end of the tour. [Mom] got the door knob covers, phone charger protector, and outlet covers. [Mom] also had the individual guiding the tour come out to check if her carseat was installed correctly since she is certified in carseat safety.


