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

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BRIGHT FUTURES SUCCESS STORY


Baby, although born early, is healthy and is gaining weight. Mom and Dad are successfully feeding him 4 oz. at each feeding about every 3 hours up from 1 or 2 oz. at birth. He is eating better and not taking quite as long to consume. He is beginning to wake up to eat at night on his own and not require stimulation to suck. He is turning to Mom and dad voices and faces over other people. . Mom got enrolled in WIC and has made it to her doctor appointments. Mom has met with me as scheduled and is returning texts asking questions and receiving information well. 
