Home Visits

Your parent educator will bring ageappropriate activities that will support your child's growth and development & parent/child interaction.

Screenings

A health, hearing and vision screening for your child is completed in your home with your support.

Following screenings, we help connect you with any resources that may be needed to help meet your child's needs.
