Your parent educator will bring age-appropriate activities that will support your child's growth and development & parent/child interaction.

Your parent educator will support you in setting goals for you and your child and help you to find ways to achieve them!

Your parent educator will help support you as a parent with the topics of attachment, discipline, health, nutrition, safety, sleep & routines.

A health, hearing and vision screening for your child is completed in your home with your support.

Following screenings, we help connect you with any resources that may be needed to help meet your child's needs.
